The INCS Fast Forward program exists to support high potential charter developers in starting new, high-quality charter schools in communities that need them. To determine if a candidate is a good fit for Fast Forward, INCS will conduct a thorough application and interview process. The application and admissions process includes the following steps:

- Initial application which will include the following components
  - Vision, Mission and Outcomes
  - Strengths and track record of leader
  - o Areas for growth of the team and the leader
  - Community you are seeking to serve
  - Fundraising capacity
  - Area(s) of charter school development (i.e., finance, operations, community engagement, facilities, etc.) do you require the most support?
- Initial interview

- Strategic planning exercise
- In-depth interview
